

COVID-19 First & Second Dose Vaccination Instructions at JIB Medical

If you have been scheduled for an appointment at JIB Medical, P.C. (“JIB Medical”) to receive the first and second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, you must follow the below instructions. For your convenience, at the time of your initial scheduling, JIB Medical will schedule both your first and second dose vaccine appointments - the second dose appointment will be scheduled to be administered to you 28 days after your first vaccine dose.

You must wear a face covering to your scheduled appointment. You will not be admitted to the site without one. Please do not come to the Joint Industry Board to be vaccinated if you feel sick on the day of your appointment. The following steps must be completed once your COVID-19 first and second dose vaccination appointment is scheduled at JIB Medical and **before** you arrive.

A. IN PREPARATION FOR THE FIRST DOSE OF THE COVID-19 VACCINE:

STEP 1: Complete the New York State COVID-19 Vaccine Form

NY State COVID-19 Vaccine Form available at: <https://forms.ny.gov/s3/vaccine>

This form must be filled out online. Choose “yes” to receive a confirmation email that you completed the New York eligibility form. You will receive a submission ID indicating completion.

⚠ You must bring the submission ID with you to your first scheduled appointment.

STEP 2: Complete the JIB Medical COVID-19 Immunization Screening & Consent Form

Please print a copy of this COVID-19 Immunization Screening & Consent Form and complete all applicable sections. Bring the completed form with you to your scheduled first vaccine dose appointment.

STEP 3: CHECKLIST Review of what to bring with you on the day of your appointment for the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine:

- Printed or digital copy of the **Submission ID** page received after completing the New York State COVID-19 Vaccine Form
- Printed and completed JIB Medical COVID-19 Immunization Screening & Consent Form

YOU MAY NOT RECEIVE THE FIRST DOSE OF THE VACCINE IF YOU DO NOT COME PREPARED WITH ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS REQUIRED BY NYS THAT ARE LISTED IN THE CHECKLIST ABOVE.

NOTE: After receiving your first dose, you will receive a vaccine card with your name, date of birth, the vaccine you received, and the place and date you received it. Keep it in a safe place and make a photocopy or take a picture just in case you lose it, as you will need it for your second dose.

B. IN PREPARATION FOR THE SECOND DOSE OF THE COVID-19 VACCINE:

STEP 1: Prepare to bring the COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card. This card was provided to you onsite when you received your first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.

STEP 2: Complete the JIB Medical COVID-19 Immunization Screening & Consent Form

Please print a copy of this COVID-19 Immunization Screening & Consent Form and complete all applicable sections. Bring the completed form with you to your scheduled second vaccine dose appointment.

STEP 3: CHECKLIST Review of what to bring with you on the day of your appointment for the second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine

- COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card (received at your first dose appointment)
- Printed and completed JIB Medical COVID-19 Immunization Screening & Consent Form

*You do not need to complete the New York State COVID-19 Vaccine Form or bring proof of eligibility for your second dose appointment.

YOU MAY NOT RECEIVE THE SECOND DOSE OF THE VACCINE IF YOU DO NOT COME PREPARED WITH ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS LISTED IN THE CHECKLIST ABOVE.
